

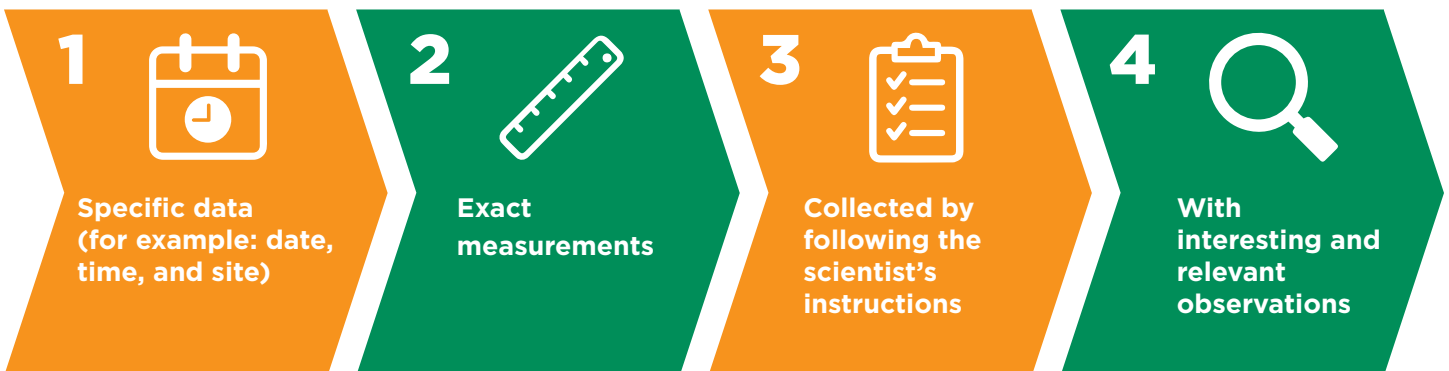
# We can all contribute to science...

- Upload photos and maintain lists of observed species.
- Increase your knowledge by talking to other naturalists.
- Help scientists and resource managers with their projects or start your own project.
- Hold an event where people try to find the largest possible number of species in a day.
