

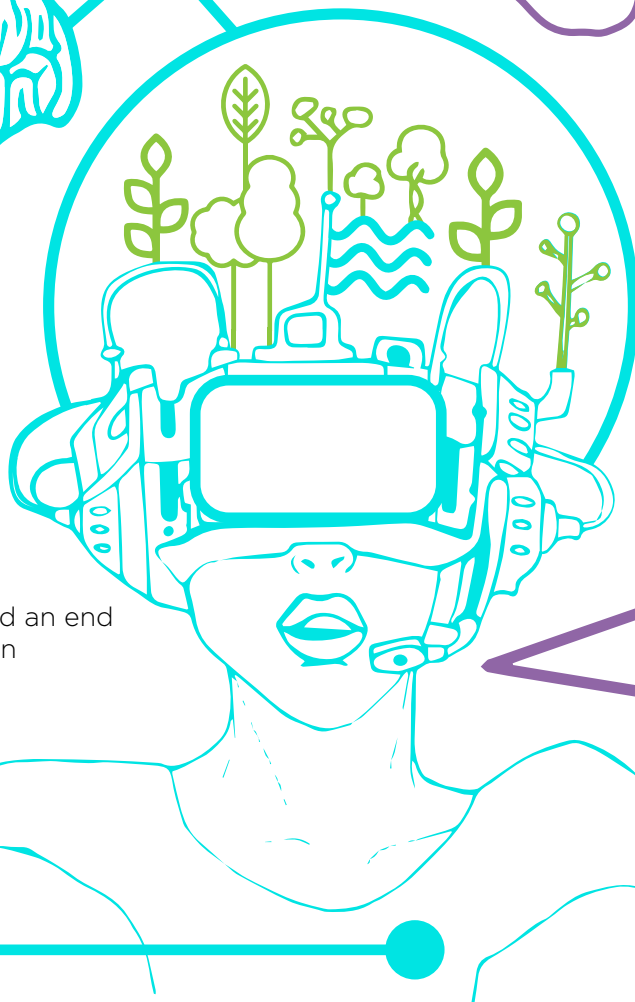
How to improve the world with a good story?
